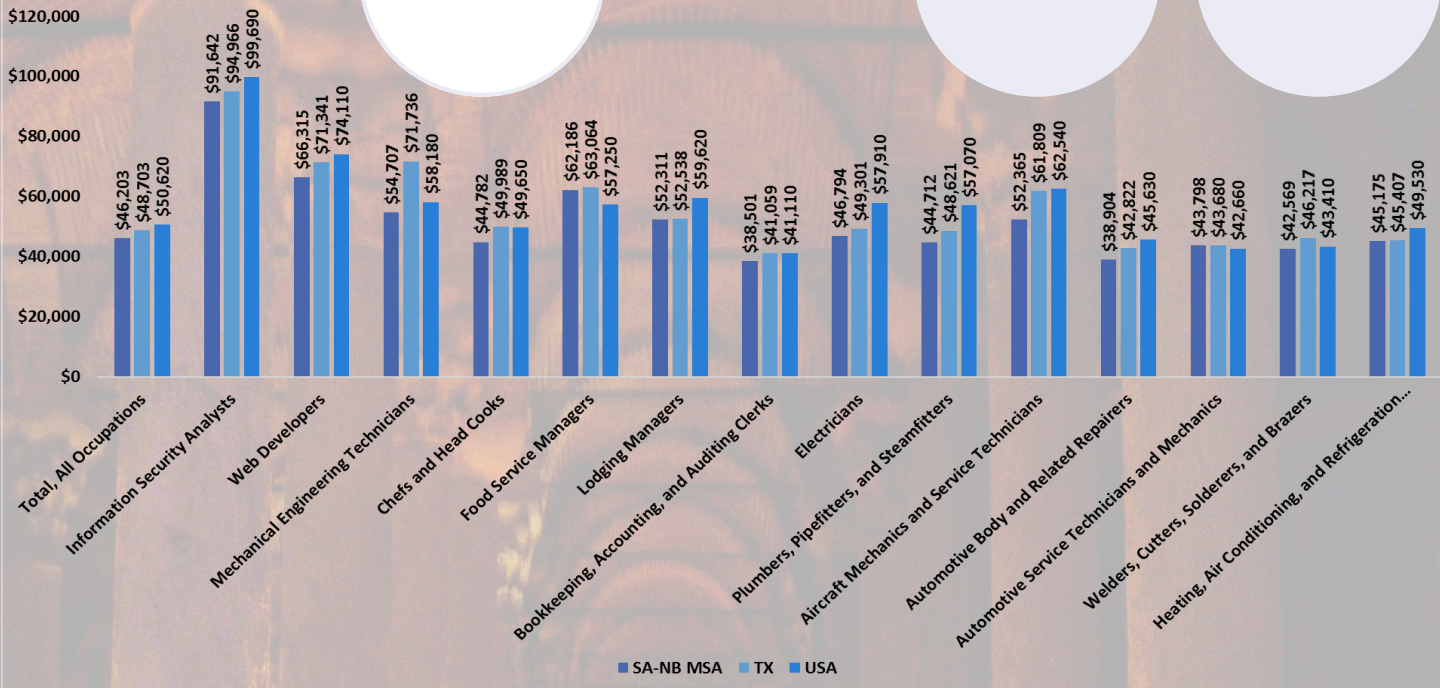


Figure 22-1 2017 Mean wage comparison (San Antonio-New Braunfels Metropolitan Statistical Area (SA-NB MSA), Texas, and National) selected AS&T occupations

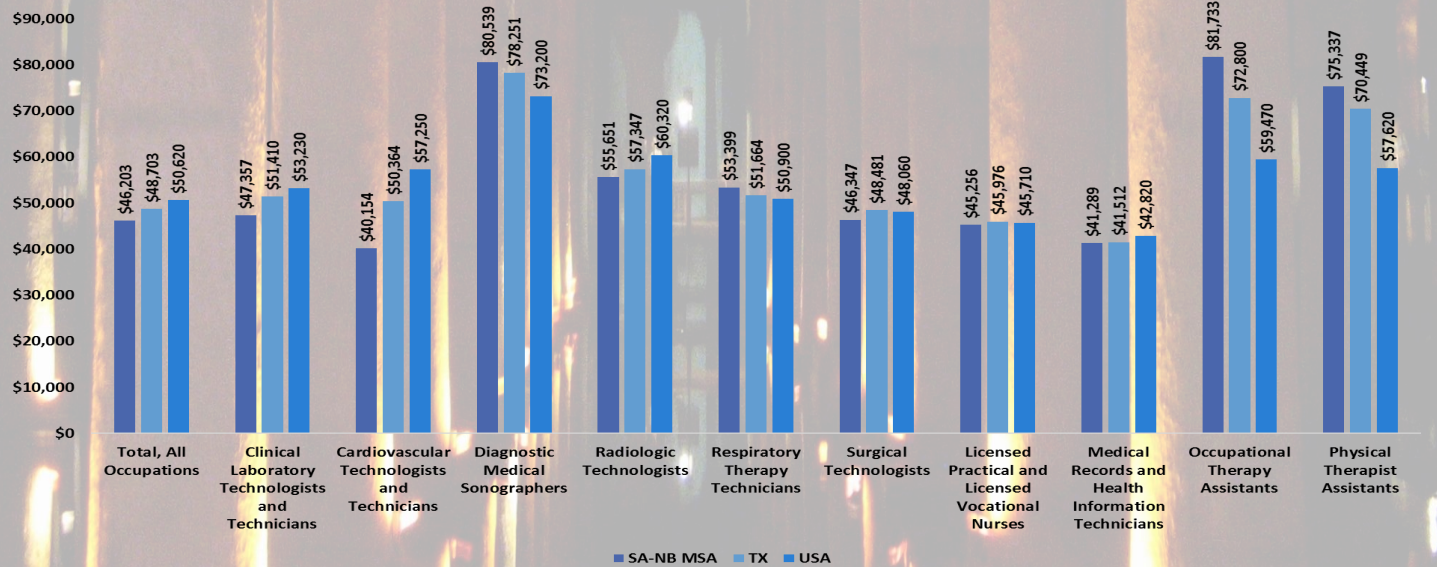


Figure 22-2 2017 Mean wage comparison (SA-NB MSA, Texas, and National) selected Health-related occupations

As seen in Figure 22-3 (above), some of the Alamo area top occupations have already surpassed the 2024 projections (radiologic technologists and respiratory therapists); these occupational fields are among those with more job postings than available applicants as of August 2018. The greatest labor shortages (indicated in red) appear in licensed practical and licensed vocational nurses, first-line supervisors of food preparation and serving workers, and web developers.
